R - For the Lord is truly risen. Alleluia.

LET US PRAY: O God, Who by the resurrection of thy Son, Our lord, Jesus Christ, hast been pleased to give joy to the whole world, grant, we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may attain the joys of eternal life. Through the same Christ Our Lord.
